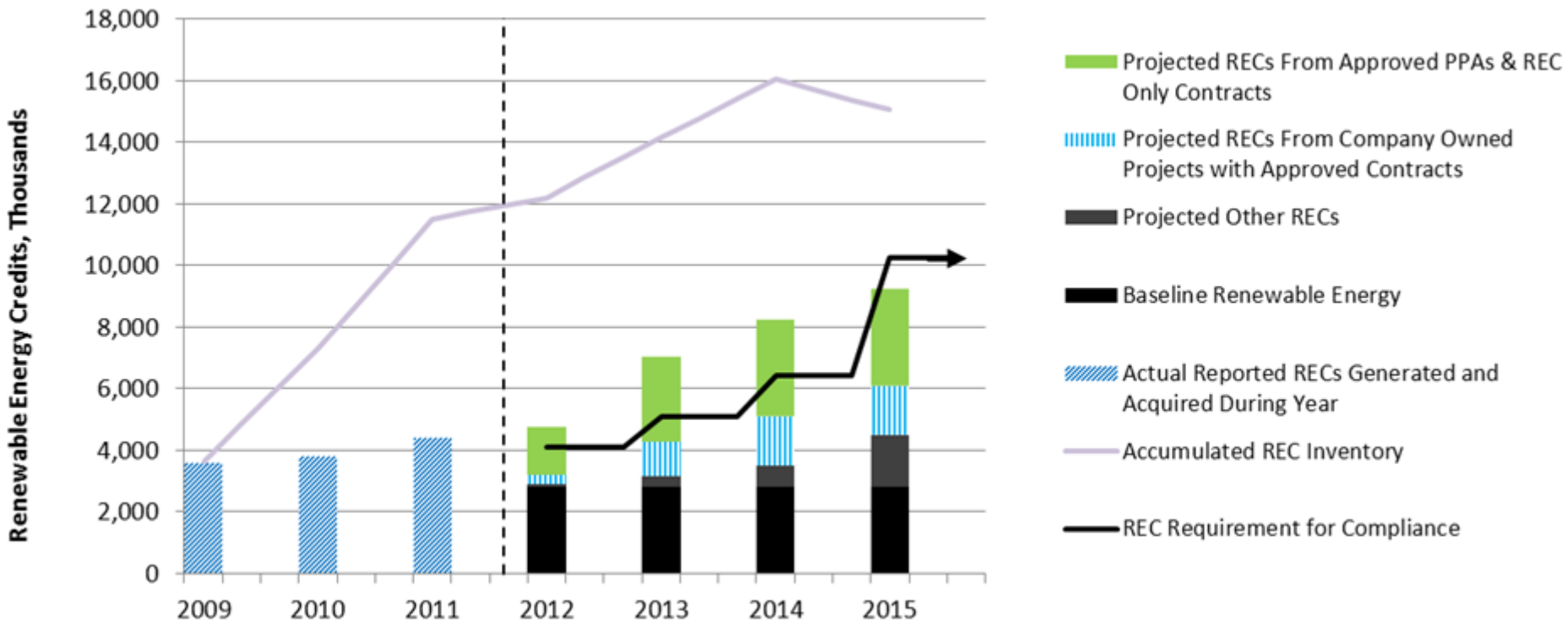
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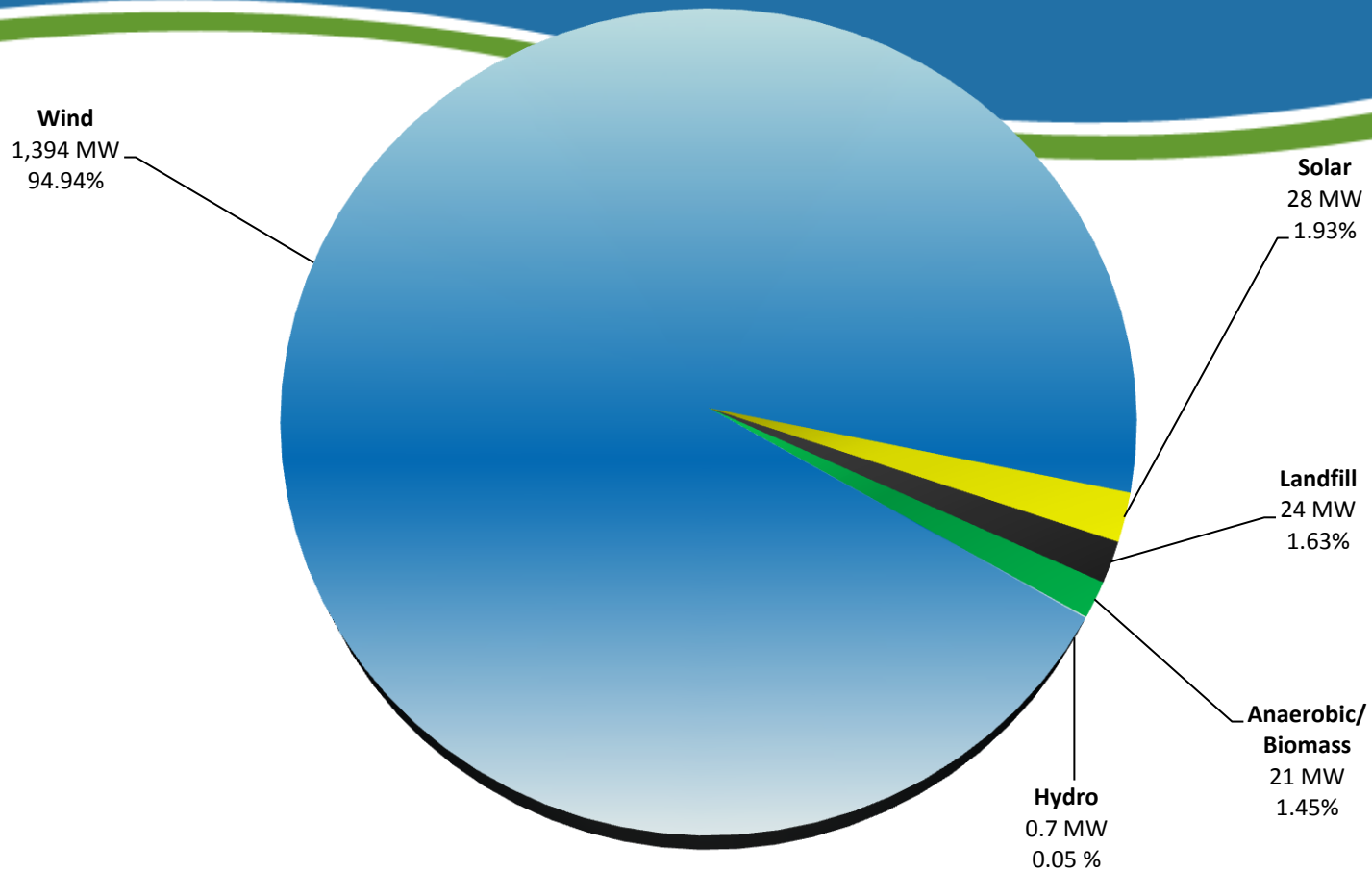

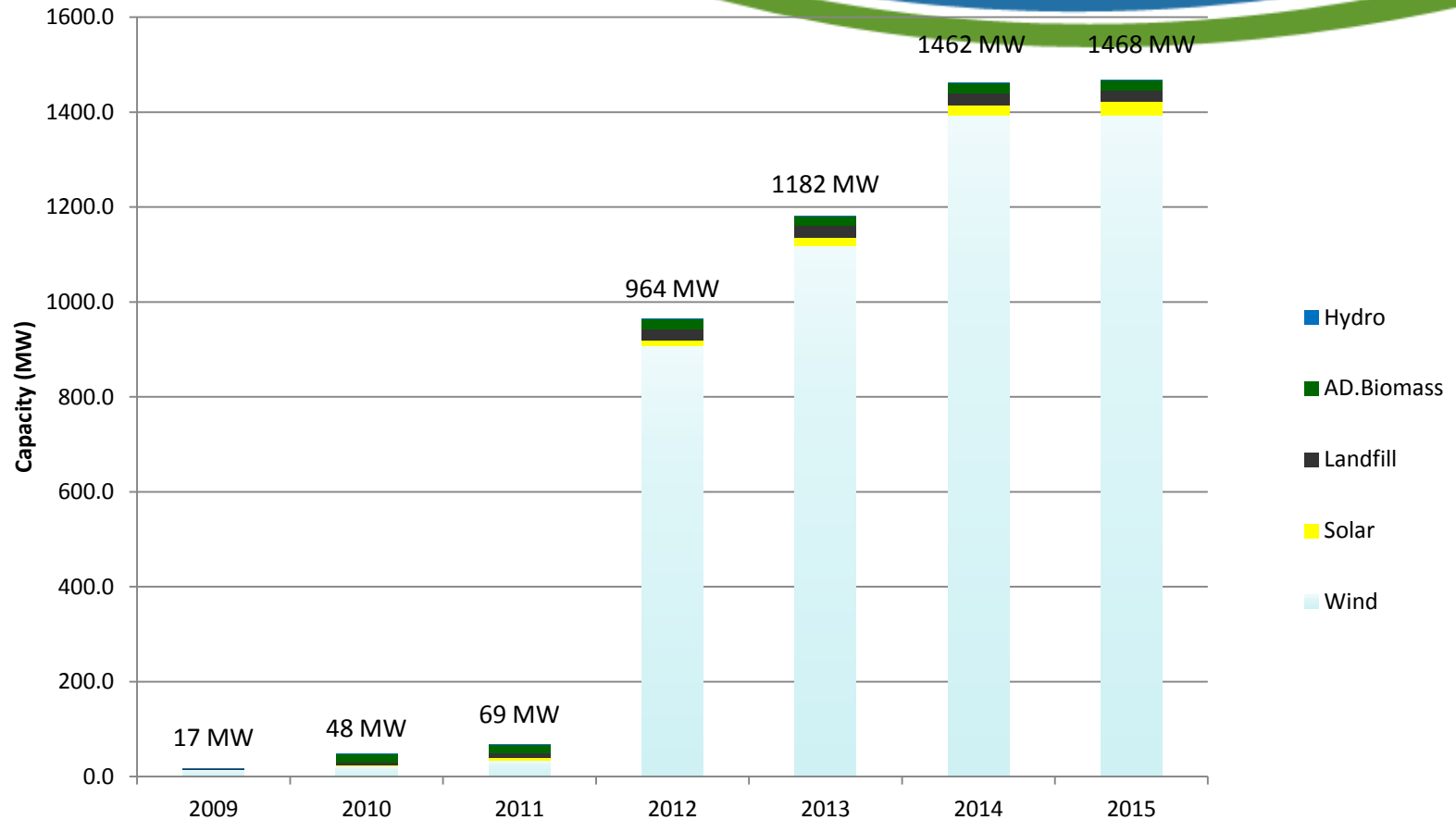

- 7 Public Forums

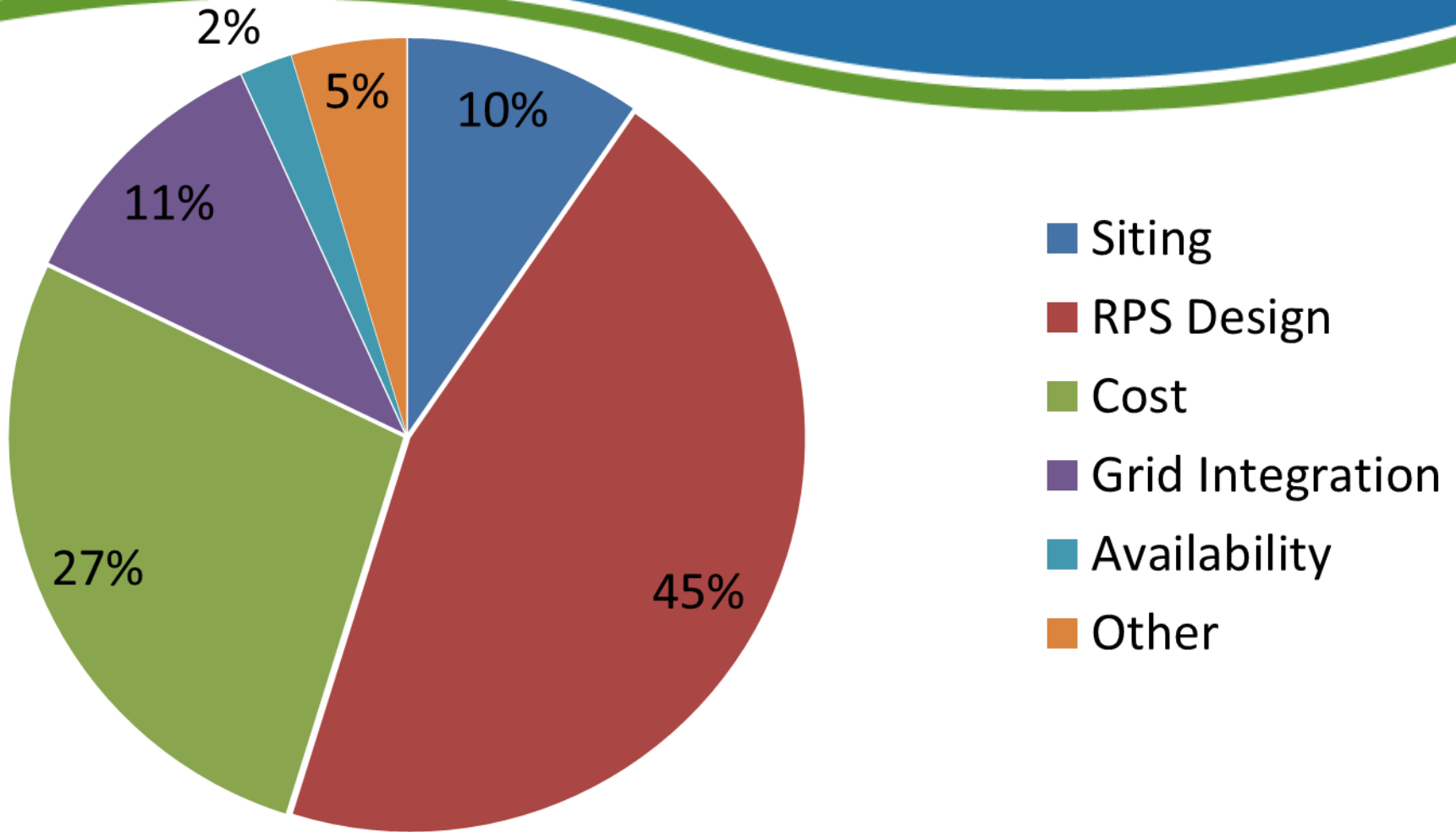


Readying Michigan Status

- Draft Report Issued September 20, 2013
- 321 Comments & 50 attachments posted
- Final Report Issued November 4, 2013
- Governor Snyder is expected to make his RE Recommendations in December.



Review of RE Comments



Report Findings

- Report does not make any policy recommendations
- Michigan on track to meet the 10% by 2015 RPS
- Michigan has enough availability RE to meet different RPS scenarios such as 15% by 2020 and 30% by 2035
- The price of renewables in Michigan has declined significantly since the passage of PA 295
