2016

• RPS Requirement Continues

"In 2016 and each year thereafter, maintain a renewable energy credit portfolio that consists of **at least** the same number of renewable energy credits as were required in 2015." –2008 PA 295(27)

## The Future? With no new legislation:

#### End of 2016

- Legislative Session Ending
- Requirement remains the same as in 2015

#### 2029

- Refund to Customers of any existing regulatory liability
- End of 20 year time line

#### 2017

- Adjustment period
- Plans Filed
- RFP for MIRECS

### The Future? SB438 Passed:

#### End of 2016

 Legislative Session Ends Having Passed into Law SB438

#### 2019-2021

Requirement Increases to 12.5%


#### Beyond 2021

 No indication is provided within the bill of if the RPS requirement continues nor if/when it ends



#### 2017 and 2018

- RPS Requirement remains the same as in 2016
- All plans reviewed in 2017



#### 2021

 Requirement Increases to 15%

### Continuing Role of Administration

- MIRECS/Tracking energy credits expectations
- Education and answering questions of providers and public
