

- Funded by Grid Resilience
 Formula Grants (section 40101(d)
 of the Infrastructure Investment
 and Jobs Act), which funds
 projects that:
 - Improve resilience
 - Generate community benefit
 - Invest in America's workforce



Program Status: California

Round 1:

- Closed October 2024
- Funded four projects
- Projects will kick off at the end of 2025

Round 2:

- Closed August 2025
- Currently scoring applications
- Anticipate submitting to DOE for review in December
